LUGGAGE: **MAXIMUM 25 LBS** IN SOFT-SIDED BAG – NO HARD SUITCASES. Please pack the bag yourself as YOU know what you need (we provide toiletries, hair dryers, linens, etc.). If you are staying in Vancouver, please leave your suitcase behind at the hotel.

Include the following: Phone, camera gear including batteries or charger, sunglasses, sunscreen warm clothing, boat gloves, hat, motion sickness & other medications.

Ensure your name is on your belongings...especially electronics.

Baggage charges are being enforced by some airlines. Check with your airlines for baggage limits as they may have changed since you last used the airline. Remember that you will have your fish box(es) on your departure. It is imperative that you do not leave the lodge without inspecting your fish box(es) & signing for the contents

IDENTIFICATION: For all U.S & International guests, a **passport is required** for travel to and from Canada. **Please check with your local government agency as to documentation required and for updates and restrictions that may affect your travel to and from Canada.** Please arrive at the airport or border crossing early.

TRAVEL TO VANCOUVER: Your destination is VANCOUVER, British Columbia. You need to be at Seair Seaplanes on the morning of your departure to the lodge no later than 8:45 a.m.

VANCOUVER TO RIVERS INLET: Direct flights from Vancouver via Seair Seaplanes, or as otherwise arranged.

PARKING: There is free parking at Seair Seaplanes or check with your hotel.

ARRIVAL BACK IN VANCOUVER: Normally back in Vancouver by 3 p.m.; do not book flights out before 5:30 p.m.
